Students are accepted as majors only on formal application after completing the published prerequisites. Deadlines for submitting applications are March 1 and November 1. Several factors are considered for acceptance because available slots are limited.			
Students will not be allowed to enroll in Soc W 322, 330, 331, 360, 361, 462 unless officially admitted to the program. After formal acceptance as a major, the course sequence is then outlined for the entire program. Without clearance from the fieldwork educational director, students cannot register for the required field experience (Soc W 496R).			
A minimum of 480 hours of social service agency experience is necessary for graduation, with 5 credit hours being issued for each 240 hours of field experience along with a weekly integrating seminar (Soc W 496R). Students must remain in the practicum a minimum of two consecutive semesters.
